## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Parents or Guardians must agree to the following policies and conditions of admission.

1. The student may not take quarter or semester exams, if their tuition account is past due.
2. No graduation or enrollment in the following year unless all amounts due are paid.
3. No participation in co-curricular activities such as sports, cheer, trips, dances, etc. if account is not current.
4. A \$35 fee will be charged for late payments, and returns for NSF checks and FACTS payments.
5. Parents and students are expected to participate in the various programs listed below.
6. The student cannot receive financial aid unless enrolled in the FACTS program
7. The front office must be informed of any change of address, email or phone numbers.
8. Students and parents must abide by all rules and regulations set forth within the Parent/Student Handbook.

## **FACTS TUITION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

1. Unless paid in full by July 31 or paid in two semester payments, monthly payments must be made from your bank account through the FACTS Tuition Management Program. This is mandatory for all students. Our Finance office can assist you in making arrangements for payment through FACTS.
2. Those without bank accounts can purchase and send money orders to FACTS.

## **TUITION ASSISTANCE** (*The student cannot receive financial aid unless enrolled in the FACTS program*)

1. Catholic Education Foundation - An annual award is available to those who qualify. Application forms for the following school year are due to Pomona Catholic by January 15.
2. Through generous contributions from individuals and foundations, limited additional tuition assistance is available.
3. Pomona Catholic can also provide assistance to those who qualify.

## **PARENT SERVICE HOURS**

Each family is obligated to render 25 hours of service per year to the school (15 hours if student has siblings at St. Joseph or St. Madeleine). The program operates from May 1st to April 30th of each year. For families with a single parent or guardian, the obligation is 12 hours per year. If this obligation is not fulfilled by April 30th, the family will be charged \$15.00 per hour for uncompleted hours. There is a buy-out option of \$375 (\$180 for single parent/guardian) payable at the beginning of the year.

## **SCRIP PROGRAM**

Pomona Catholic participates with a number of merchants in a scrip program. The Scrip program is mandatory for families with students enrolled at Pomona Catholic and operates from May 1<sup>st</sup> to April 30th each year. Each family has an obligation to purchase enough scrip each year to generate a total rebate amount of \$200. After that amount has been reached, the rebates will be shared on a 50/50 basis. The Scrip obligation can be bought out at the beginning of the school year for \$200.

## **FUNDRAISERS**

In the Fall and Spring of each year raffle and walkathon fundraisers are held. Parents, relatives and friends purchase \$200 worth of tickets with the opportunity to receive prizes. Parents may choose to opt out of these fundraisers by paying a \$400 fee at the beginning of the year. Also during the year, a Casino Night is held. Families are required to purchase (or sell to others) two tickets at a cost of \$45 each (prior to the event). Throughout the year, there are other events that are enjoyable to attend and vital to the financial health of the school including the Car Show, drama presentations and various athletic events.

## **ANNUAL GIVING PROGRAM**

The Felician Fund Program was established to honor the work of our Felician Sisters throughout Pomona Catholic's history. The Felician Fund enhances Pomona Catholic's programs with gifts that support our school environment and academic programs. The Felician Fund Program allows us to strengthen our school by adding resources and activities that are suitable to our students' needs such as technology, class retreats, field trips and more. Each family should make a gift that is appropriate to their circumstances, but at a minimum we ask for gifts of at least \$100 per year. These gifts are tax deductible and may be provided in periodic payments throughout the year.

## **ADOPT A STUDENT**

Our Adopt a Student program is directed at helping those families who would not be able to attend Pomona Catholic without financial assistance. Individuals, businesses, foundations, etc. will be given the opportunity to have their contributions linked directly to a student, a student that qualifies for the Adopt a Student Program.
