#### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Parents or Guardians must agree to the following policies and conditions of admission.

1. It is a condition of enrollment that all student financial accounts are active through FACTS Tuition Management.
2. The student may not take quarter or semester exams, if their tuition account is past due.
3. No graduation or enrollment in the following term unless all balances are current.
4. No participation in co-curricular activities such as sports, cheer, trips, dances, etc. if account is not current.
5. A \$35 fee will be charged for late payments, and returns for NSF checks and FACTS payments.
6. Parents and students are expected to participate in the various programs listed below.
7. The student may not receive financial aid unless there is a completed FACTS Grant & Aid application.
8. The front office must be promptly informed of any change of address, email or phone numbers – you may update your contact information through the Parent Portal.
9. Students and parents must abide by all rules and regulations set forth within the Parent/Student Handbook.

#### **FACTS TUITION MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

1. For your convenience, all payments must be made through FACTS Tuition Management. Monthly payments, incidental charges (for example, athletic fees, fundraising obligations not met, etc.) must be made through the FACTS Tuition Management. This is mandatory for all students. The Business Office can assist you in making arrangements for payment through FACTS.
2. You may use credit cards for your FACTS payments, but will be accessed a fee through FACTS.

**TUITION ASSISTANCE** *(Students are not eligible for tuition assistance without a complete FACTS Grant & Application – Pomona Catholic is dedicated to covering the demonstrated need of all students to fulfil our mission of making Catholic education available to those who would otherwise not have access)*

1. Catholic Education Foundation - annual awards are available to those who qualify. Due dates are governed by CEF – for returning students December of the previous year and for new students upon application/admissions. Contact Pomona Catholic Business Office directly for more information and applications.
2. Through generous contributions from individuals and foundations, limited additional tuition assistance is available and you must apply through FACTS Grant & Aid at <https://online.factsmtg.com/aid>.
3. Pomona Catholic may provide assistance to those who qualify based on financial aid application by applying through FACTS Grant & Aid at <https://online.factsmtg.com/aid>.

#### **PARENT SERVICE HOURS**

Each family is obligated to render 25 hours of service per year to the school. The program operates from May 1st to April 30th of each year. If this obligation is not fulfilled by April 30th, the family will be charged \$15 per hour for uncompleted hours. There is a buy-out option of \$375 payable at the beginning of the year.

#### **SCRIP PROGRAM**

Pomona Catholic participates with a number of merchants in a scrip program. The Scrip program is mandatory for families with students enrolled at Pomona Catholic and operates from May 1<sup>st</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup> each year. Each family has an obligation to purchase enough scrip each year to generate a total rebate amount of \$200. After the obligation has been met, any additional proceeds go to the school general fund. The Scrip obligation can be bought out at the beginning of the school year for \$200.

#### **FUNDRAISERS**

In the fall and spring of each year raffle and walk-a-thon fundraisers are held. Parents, relatives, and friends may purchase tickets with the opportunity to receive prizes (\$200 minimum obligation). Parents may choose to opt out of these fundraisers by paying a \$400 fee at the beginning of the year. Also during the year, the school hosts a Casino Night Event. Families are required to purchase (or sell to others) two tickets at a cost of \$50 each. Throughout the year, there are other events which are enjoyable to attend and vital to the financial health of the school including the Car Show, drama presentations, and various athletic events.

#### **ANNUAL GIVING PROGRAM**

The Felician Fund Program was established to honor the work of our Felician Sisters throughout Pomona Catholic's history. The Felician Fund enhances Pomona Catholic's programs with gifts that support our school environment and academic programs. The Felician Fund Program allows us to strengthen our school by adding resources and activities that are suitable to our students' needs such as technology, class retreats, field trips and more. Each family should make a gift that is appropriate to their circumstances, but the school asks for a gift of at least \$100 each year. These gifts are tax deductible and may be provided in periodic payments throughout the year.
